

Public Notice:

THE WISCONSIN ARMY NATIONAL GUARD (WIARNG) INVITES THE PUBLIC TO LEARN ABOUT AND PROVIDE INPUT IN THE ENVIRONMENTAL INVESTIGATION AND CLEANUP ACTIVITIES AT WEST BEND ARMY AVIATION SUPPORT FACILITY (AASF #1) AND ARMORY IN WEST BEND, WISCONSIN.

Administrative Record:

The WIARNG is conducting an environmental investigation for per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) at West Bend AASF #1 and Armory in West Bend, Wisconsin. An Administrative Record has been established in support of these investigation activities. The Administrative Record is a file maintained by the Army National Guard (ARNG) which will include selected technical reports, fact sheets, general information, and other relevant documents used to make decisions throughout the response action. To ensure information about the PFAS work at West Bend AASF #1 and Armory is available to interested citizens, the ARNG will maintain these records at the West Bend Community Memorial Library located at 630 Poplar St., West Bend, WI 53095, (262) 335-5151.

The ARNG is also soliciting public interest in establishing a Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) for PFAS remedial investigation activities at West Bend AASF #1 and Armory.

What is a RAB?

A RAB is a community group which meets to discuss and receive information on environmental restoration (cleanup of contamination) projects at a military facility.

What does a RAB do?

A RAB enables local community members interested in environmental cleanup to receive and exchange information with the regulatory agencies and National Guard personnel managing environmental cleanup activities at West Bend AASF #1 and Armory. At meetings, RAB members and the public can receive updates and ask questions on the status of the environmental cleanup program at West Bend AASF #1 and Armory.

Although RABs are not a decision-making group, RABs do give local community members the opportunity to have their voices heard and to provide valuable community insight to the facility and regulatory agencies.
