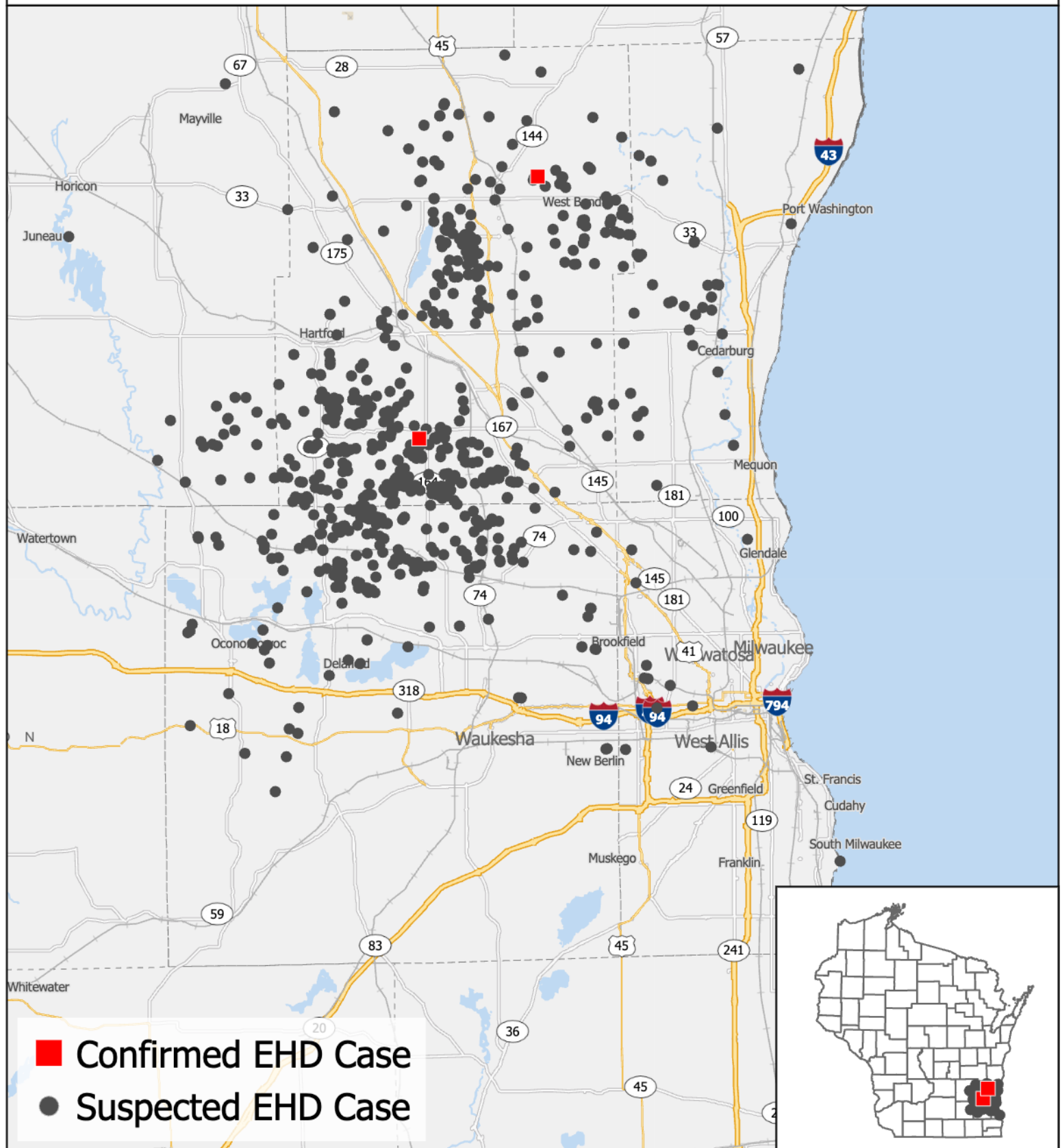


2026 Preliminary Wisconsin EHD Status

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The 2026 Preliminary Epizootic Hemorrhagic Disease (EHD) Status Map displays both confirmed and suspected cases of EHD in Wisconsin as red squares for confirmed and grey points for suspected. The map is zoomed in to the southeast portion of the state, where the majority of cases are clustered. There is heavy clustering in Washington County, with the most points in the central and southwest areas of the county and additional clusters in northern Waukesha County, southern Ozaukee County and eastern and southeastern Dodge County. The only two confirmed cases are in northeast and southern Washington County. There are additional suspected cases throughout Washington County, as well as farther south in Waukesha County and northern Ozaukee County, and eleven cases in Milwaukee County. There is a basemap of county boundaries, roads, and waterways for orientation. In the lower right corner of the map is an inset map of Wisconsin state and county outlines and the confirmed and suspected EHD cases to indicate that the primary map shows southeastern Wisconsin.
